There was much agreement which bodes well for the next editing phase when 4 representatives get together. Coral will be speaking for us.

As I write, that process is under way. Emma Hopkins of Marks Tey, with experience of producing media documents is committed with producing the final document in booklet form which will be attractive to potential applicants.

On 29 January a further meeting will take place with the patron, CPAS, who should be able to produce a short list of applicants.
