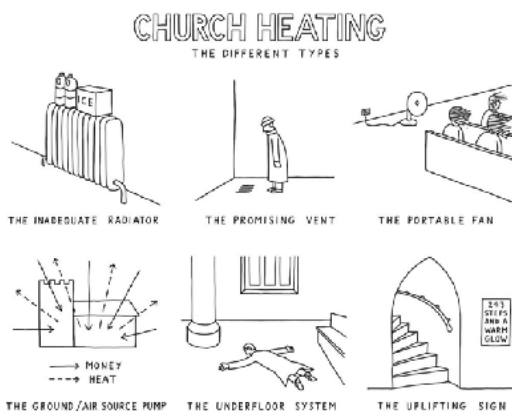
The Shoebox Appeal
